



Install Post-Mounted Reflective Delineators at the Intersection

Implementation of post-mounted reflective delineators along the major road at the intersection to promote driver awareness of the intersection, especially during nighttime conditions.

Targeted Crash Types

- Right-angle
- Rear-end (major road)

Problems Addressed

- Inadequate visibility of intersection or intersection traffic control devices

Conditions Addressed

- History of nighttime crashes.
- Remote stretches in which intersections may not be conspicuous to drivers along the major road.
- Poor nighttime visibility of the intersection from at least one approach.

Considerations

- Delineators are considered guidance devices rather than warning devices.
- The color of the delineator should be consistent with the color of the edge lines.
- This treatment can be applied as delineators placed only at the intersection along roads that do not have delineators for the entire corridor; or
